



Get ready seniors, Southridge 2022 Grad Night is right around the corner! **Read the following to ensure there are no surprises.** We look forward to celebrating with you and wish you a wonderful graduation experience over the next few weeks – you deserve it!

THURSDAY, JUNE 9, 2022 | 6:00 P.M. TO 1:00 A.M.

- **GRAD NIGHT IS A SOBER/DRUG FREE NIGHT**
You can expect the same school rules and processes to apply to grad night – breathalyzer included. Any inappropriate behavior or the appearance of intoxication at check in or during the event will be disciplined by immediate removal from the bus or party. Parents/Guardian will be called to pick up their students. No re-admittance will be allowed.
- **YOU MUST BE COMPLETELY REGISTERED TO ATTEND**
This means all three registration forms are completed and turned in to the office AND the ticket is paid for. Registration is closed now, therefore no additional tickets are available for purchase due to the nature of the event. If you missed registering for a bus in May, no worries, we assigned you a spot on an open bus.
- **DO NOT BE LATE – DOORS OPEN AT 6 P.M.**
You are expected to be at Southridge High School for check in at this time. Plus, you don't want to miss the prize and raffle kick-off – you need to be present to win! Buses will be loaded shortly after 6 p.m. and you must be checked in to load buses. You must ride the bus to and from to attend.
- **BRING ID TO PRESENT AT CHECK-IN**
For registered students who do not show up before buses leave, their parents/guardians will receive a courtesy call letting them know their student didn't check in.
- **DRESS CASUALLY, IN COMFORTABLE CLOTHES, DON'T FORGET TO WEAR SOCKS!**
- **ALL PERSONAL ITEMS MUST BE CHECKED IN**
Keep personal items to a minimum. They will be checked in at the personal check-in station prior to loading the bus, and will remain checked in at Southridge throughout the duration of the event (jackets, cellphones, purses, bags, backpacks, cameras, electronics, etc.). We completely understand the idea of being away from your phone is likely painful for you to hear (it pains us to require this!), but it's for your own safety, our event regulations require it, and ultimately, it's only for a short period of time -- thank you for understanding. A photographer will be onsite throughout the event. Students will be provided access to photos after the event.
- **STUDENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE EVENT ONCE THEY HAVE CHECKED IN**
In case of illness, injury or emergency, the emergency contact on the student's registration form will be contacted to pick up the student. The student will not be allowed to return to the party.
- **ALL MEDICATIONS MUST BE CHECKED IN/ REVIEWED AT THE NURSES STATION**
All allergies and medications required by the student during the event must be listed on the student's forms. All medications will travel with the student throughout the event via nurse volunteers.
- **PARENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO PICK UP THEIR STUDENTS OR CARPOOL STUDENTS**
This will ensure their safe arrival home. In the event students drive on their own and park in the Southridge parking lot, we cannot guarantee security for the vehicle.
